
Place Value To Hundreds

Place value worksheets


After learning the place value to tens, kids in 2nd grade are ready to learn <u>place value to hundreds</u>. The basics are same, as "ones" are organized to sticks when we have more than ten "ones". Similarly, tens (sticks) are organized into "one hundred (flat), when there are ten or more (sticks).

For example; look at the picture below and count the number of ones, all together.



Above, we have 136 ones all together, including 86 ones and 5 tens (stick). All the ones can be organized into tens. But, there will be too many tens (sticks), this way.

In this lesson, we will learn how to organize ten sticks into one flat or hundred as shown below;



See, how easy it is to count when ones are organized into tens and tens are bundled into hundreds.

For eighty six ones and five tens, we get one hundred (flat), three tens (sticks) and six ones.

Below is the place value chart to hundreds.

So, let's start learning place value to hundreds!!

Hundreds	Tens	Ones	Number	Number in expanded form
1	3	6	136	100 + 30 + 6

Number in words = $\underline{\text{One hundred thirty six}}$
