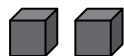
Place Value Worksheets

To understand the place value to tens, let's refresh our memory about the counting from one to ten. The small cube at right is one or unit.



One or 1

Two of small cubes like this mean two and so on as shown below:



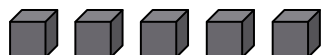
Two or 2

Five or 5



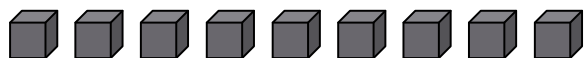
Six or 6



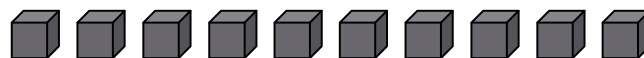
Seven or 7



Eight or 8



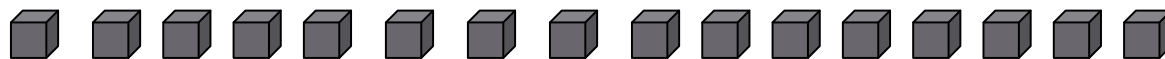
Nine or 9

Introduction to tens or a stick:

Consider there are 16 ones as shown below.



Sixteen or 16 ones

This can be shown by regrouping these ones into tens and ones. To make counting large numbers easier, ten ones are bundled together to make one ten or a stick. This is done as shown below:



Ten Ones

One Tens (It is called a Stick)

So, sixteen ones can be written as; "One Tens" and "Six Ones", as shown below:
