

## Rounding numbers base builder worksheet - 2

### Worksheets to make rounding numbers easy

In this activity kids will be given a number and they have to pick two nearest tens to that number. This worksheet contains multiple choice questions. First problem is done as an example and 2nd grade math students should be able to finish the rest of the problems.

**Circle the two nearest tens to the given number.**

Hint: One of the tens is less than the given number and the other one is greater. Try your best to pick the right choice.

1) Pick two nearest tens to 559

- A. 570 and 590
- B. 810 and 820
- C. 550 and 565

*Hint:* Look for ones and tens digits only and underline them. As I underlined 59 in 559. Now you know that 59 is between 50 & 60.

Answer is d) 550 and 560
