

# Rounding numbers base builder worksheet - 3

## Worksheets to make rounding numbers easy

In this activity kids will be given a number and they have to pick two nearest hundreds to that number. This worksheet contains multiple choice questions. Skip counting by hundreds may help kids on this topic. First problem is done as an example. You do the rest to prove yourself.

**Circle the two nearest hundreds to the given number.**

**Hint: One of the tens is less than the given number and the other one is greater. Try your best to pick the right choice.**

**1) Pick two nearest hundreds to 867**

- A. 810 and 870
- B. 860 and 870
- C. 800 and 900
- D. 100 and 800

*Hint:* Look at two exact hundreds which got the hundreds place digit of given number is between. Here numbers are 800 and 900.

**Answer is c) 800 and 900**

**2) Pick two nearest hundreds to 709**

- A. 700 and 800
- B. 700 and 710
- C. 100 and 800
- D. 800 and 900

**3) Pick two nearest hundreds to 196**

- A. 190 and 900
- B. 100 and 200
- C. 100 and 1000
